Many individuals and families that live in these suburbs today experience extreme disadvantage and marginalisation from the rest of society. Others experience language and cultural barriers. Others have always lived in this area and have retired and remained in this area.

We are a church with many faithful brothers and sisters but our resources are minimal. We need your help as we partner in the gospel. We are so thankful to churches that have sent people to partner in the form of tradies who did hours of free work on our property, churches who donated large sums to repair parts of our property, lay people who spent hours gardening and others who came to preach to allow our minister to rest. The community of Sadleir and surrounds enjoy community together and in the past we have seen many families join the church community and become followers of Jesus through outreach events and chaplaincy among community. On the 17th of December we are planning another outreaching event.
